

PHD-PROTOCOL

Human Rights in the Mediterranean International PhD d'Université EMUI_ EuroMed University & Consortium

As a development of § Article 1.2.2 [*Statutes and Regulations*, OBEMUI, Nr 26 / 2020.1 (January-June)], the Executive Commission approves this Protocol, on March 31, 2020.

The degree of Doctor of University by the EMUI_ EuroMed University [Tax Nr: ESG87905626 · PIC 913475094 · Reg. Nr: M 39.657] is the result of an integration process of academic networks which work on European and Mediterranean issues. It is aimed at educating professionals with a specific vision, with the capacity to foment the integration among Europe, the South and the East Mediterranean. Therefore, the priority lines are: the evolution of the European integration and the operation of its institutions, the development of the legal and economic infrastructures, the development cooperation, the socio-economic European culture, the community policies and especially their Euro-Mediterranean projection. Thus it is offered a postgraduate course of excellence, which permits the acquisition of theoretical and practical knowledge and the expertness of its students in European Union issues.

Registration Process: In order to be admitted to a 'Doctorat d'Université', it will be necessary: a) to design a research project, with full freedom of format, recommending brevity and, if possible, a maximum of five pages; b) curriculum vitae; c) justify timeliness and possible effectiveness (added value) of the proposed project; d) an interuniversity commission will inform each of the projects and will make its evaluation available, within a maximum period of three months; e) from the publication of the reference resolution, the candidat has a **maximum of 18 months** to write and present his thesis; e) languages: French, Italian, English and Spanish.

Tuition Fess: When the Commission positively evaluates the project (and communicates it to the candidate) it is considered admissible, once the candidate enters the registration fee (€ 200.00) in the EMUI institutional account. For the defense of the thesis the candidate must enter the corresponding rights (€ 600.00), which include the fees and travel of the members of the Commission as well as the issuance of the corresponding document. The approved theses could be published in the Editorial of the EMUI_ EuroMed University, www.euromeditations.eu

Procedure: It is the responsibility of the Vice-President of Research and Studies (and, on his behalf, the Technical Secretary General):

- 1.- Evaluate the proposals presented, and accept them, if applicable.
- 2.- Appoint the Commission that will evaluate the accepted thesis
- 3.- The Commission shall issue a report on the eligibility of the thesis to submit it, in the event of a public evaluation.
- 4.- The Commission shall consider the report issued by the Thesis Director, without the report being binding.
- 5.- The Vice-President of Research and Studies (and, on his behalf, the Technical Secretary General) will call, in due course, the doctoral student, publicizing the composition of the Commission and indicating, where appropriate, through which virtual medium the academic act will be held.
